**The Roman's Road To Salvation**

**1st. it explains the natural condition of man in relation to God:**

"...There is none righteous, no, not one..." Romans 3:10 "For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God" Romans 3:23 "For the wages of sin is death..." Romans 6:23a

**2nd. it describes God's provision for our salvation (entrance into Heaven) in the person of Jesus Christ by His death on the cross:**

"But God commendeth (displayed) his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us." Romans 5:8 "For as by one man's (Adam's) disobedience many were made sinners, so by the obedience of one (Jesus) shall many be made righteous (cleansed of sin in the eyes of God). Romans 5:19

**3rd. it explains what we have to do to receive the gift of Salvation:**

"...but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord." Romans 6:23b "...That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved." Romans 10:9

\*\*\*When we repent of our sin(s), & by faith accept & receive God's offer of salvation, we then can humbly pray to Him and be saved, and have a changed life forever! (Acts 20:21; 1 Cor. 5:17)
